

# Missing Push Notification Entitlement Warning Remover

Being tired of getting "*Missing Push Notification Entitlement*" warning every time you create new version of your iOS app?

**Missing Push Notification Entitlement** - Your app appears to include API used to register with the Apple Push Notification service, but the app signature's entitlements do not include the "aps-environment" entitlement. If your app uses the Apple Push Notification service, make sure your App ID is enabled for Push Notification in the Provisioning Portal, and resubmit after signing your app with a Distribution provisioning profile that includes the "aps-environment" entitlement. See "Provisioning and Development" in the [Local and Push Notification Programming Guide](#) for more information. If your app does not use the Apple Push Notification service, no action is required. You may remove the API from future submissions to stop this warning. If you use a third-party framework, you may need to contact the developer for information on removing the API.

This is caused by unused notification-related code generated by Unity. Plugin simply removes it from your source files after you create an Xcode project. It won't cause any side-effects if you don't use push notifications.

## Setup

Make sure that *MissingPushNotificationEntitlementRemover.cs* file is inside your *Editor* directory. **Do not** use that plugin if you are planning to use push notifications!
